Government Meetings and Representations



Meeting with Hon'ble Minister for Civil Aviation, Shri Ram Mohan Naidu

The CREDAI delegation, comprising President Mr. Shekhar Patel, Secretary Mr. Gaurav Gupta, and Vice President Mr. Ashish Patel, met with Hon'ble Minister for Civil Aviation, Shri Ram Mohan Naidu to extend an invitation to the CREDAI National Conclave and Real Estate Awards, scheduled for 19th and 20th December. The Hon'ble Minister graciously confirmed his participation in the Conclave.

The discussion also covered the activities of the Joint Working Group (JWG) established to address challenges related to height clearances around airports. The Minister shared that the Ministry of Civil Aviation is preparing a comprehensive report in collaboration with international aviation agencies.

A set of recommendations on height clearances across airports in India will be finalized in consultation with CREDAI and other relevant stakeholders within the next 2–3 months.



Representation to the Chairman, CBIC & representatives of CBDT

The CREDAI delegation, led by President Mr. Shekhar Patel and comprising Mr. Gaurav Gupta and Ms. Binitha Dalal, made a presentation to the Chairman of CBIC and representatives of the CBD, as part of our ongoing advocacy for the Union Budget 2026–27.

The delegation outlined key industry recommendations on Direct and Indirect Taxes to further strengthen the real estate and housing sector.

The proposals highlighted included refining the definition of Affordable Housing, facilitating GST Input Tax Credit (ITC), reducing GST on works contracts, introducing a Credit Guarantee Scheme for Affordable Housing, and launching a National Rental Housing Mission to address the growing housing demand.

CSR Foundation and **Skilling Initiative**











Representation to the Hon'ble Minister for Municipal Administration & Urban Development

On 15th October, a delegation comprising representatives from CREDAI-MCHI, NAREDCO, and BDA met Shri Aseem Gupta, Additional Chief Secretary (UD-I), and Shri Satish Gite to discuss and request an extension of the Deferment Policy.

During the meeting, the delegation presented a three-fold request: to make the deferment policy applicable to all approving agencies, including MCGM, MHADA, SRA, and others; to make the deferment a permanent policy rather than requiring extensions every three years; and to maintain the interest rate at 8% under the deferment policy.

All three points were positively accepted by the Urban Development Secretary. Additionally, the delegation has requested a joint meeting to deliberate on other issues related to Urban Development.

Subsequently, the team met Shri Chandrakant Undge, Shri Chandrashekhar Chore, and Shri Sharad Ughade (DMC – Health) to touch upon several issues within their respective areas of jurisdiction.

A follow-up meeting is planned post-Diwali to continue discussions on multiple matters, including the ongoing concerns surrounding Regulation 33(12).



Meeting with Shri Bhushan Gagrani (I.A.S.), Municipal Commissioner, BMC

On 24th October, a marathon meeting was convened by Shri Sukhraj Nahar, President of CREDAI-MCHI, bringing together representatives from CREDAI-MCHI, NAREDCO, BDA, and PEATA with Hon'ble Municipal Commissioner Shri Bhushan Gagrani (I.A.S.) and senior MCGM

officials including Shri Chandrakant Undge, Shri Sunil Rathod, Shri Chandrashekhar Chore, Shri Ravindra Ambulgekar, Shri Parab, Shri Kate, and Shri Nirmal.

A key outcome of the meeting was the formation of a Real Estate Steering Committee under the chairmanship of Shri Chandrakant Undge, tasked with convening fortnightly meetings with representatives from all developer associations and MCGM officers to ensure real-time resolution of industry issues.

The Municipal Commissioner also assured his personal participation on a monthly basis. Additionally, CREDAI-MCHI, in collaboration with NAREDCO, BDA, and PEATA, proposed a 10:10:80 premium payment mechanism covering Fungible FSI, OSD, Fire Service Fees, PCO Charges, Development Cess, and other related heads—a transformative initiative aimed at improving industry cash flows.

The Municipal Commissioner welcomed the proposal and advised that it be further deliberated within the Steering Committee.

Meeting with Shri Satish Gite - OSD to ACS

A meeting was held on 27th October with Shri Satish Gite, Officer on Special Duty (OSD) to the Additional Chief Secretary (ACS), to discuss the extension of the deferment policy for State Government premiums. During the discussion, CREDAI-MCHI requested a reduction of the interest rate to 8.5%. It was clarified, however, that since BMC and SRA have already increased their rates to 12%, the Urban Development (UD) Department cannot mandate a lower rate.

The matter of interest rate rationalization remains under consideration, contingent upon alignment with the policies of local authorities such as BMC and SRA.



Meeting with Dr. Mahendra Kalyankar (IAS) - CEO, SRA

On 30th October, a joint delegation comprising CREDAI-MCHI, NAREDCO, BDA, and PEATA visited the Slum Rehabilitation Authority (SRA) at the invitation of Dr. Mahendra Kalyankar (IAS), CEO, SRA, to engage in a detailed discussion on the Authority's reform initiatives. During the interaction, Dr. Kalyankar and his leadership team highlighted a transformative agenda focused on making SRA processes faster, transparent, and technology driven.

Key initiatives include the launch of an STQC-certified website available in over 25 languages, a fully integrated online approval system with role-based access, blockchain-based record storage for enhanced transparency, and Al-driven chatbots to facilitate seamless interaction with beneficiaries and developers.

Additionally, real-time validation of Aadhaar, PAN, electricity, and electoral data now enables instant generation of Annexure-2, reducing approval timelines from 6–9 months to near-instant.

On the governance front, SRA is undertaking comprehensive mapping of all slum structures in Mumbai by year-end, along with time-bound eviction and demolition SOPs, allowing non-cooperative slum structures to be cleared within 45 days, as demonstrated by the demolition of 1,000 structures in Worli within just three days.

SRA 2.0 embodies speed, transparency, technology-enabled governance, and a developer-friendly environment, reflecting the Authority's commitment to a slum-free Mumbai and its willingness to collaborate with credible developers.

CREDAI-MCHI will now coordinate with SRA to organize a developer workshop and demonstration session in the near future.

CAQM, IIT Delhi & CREDAI NCR Reviewed "Clean Construction Guidelines" For Dust-Free Development in NCR Region

A high-level meeting was held on 13th October at the CAQM Headquarters in Delhi under the chairmanship of Shri Rajesh Verma, Chairman, Commission for Air Quality Management (CAQM), to review and finalize the Clean Construction Guidelines and Techno-Managerial Solutions aimed at reducing dust and particulate pollution from construction and demolition (C&D) activities across Delhi-NCR.

CREDAI NCR was represented by Shri Nikhil Hawelia in close coordination with Shri Gaurav Gupta, along with representatives from CAQM, IIT Delhi, the School of Planning and Architecture (SPA), and CPWD. The meeting focused on developing practical, enforceable measures that align construction practices with national environmental laws, GRAP triggers, and the C&D Waste Management Rules.

The jointly developed guidelines, a result of collaboration between CAQM, IIT Delhi, SPA, CPWD, and CREDAI NCR, emphasize five key pillars — air-quality-based construction scheduling, adoption of low-dust technologies, strengthened dust suppression controls, digital monitoring through sensors and dashboards, and circularity in waste management through Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR).

The measures are expected to achieve measurable reductions in construction-related emissions, ensure cleaner project delivery, and enhance accountability across projects. Shri Rajesh Verma appreciated the collaborative effort between academia, government, and industry, stating that clean construction must become a deliverable rather than an aspiration. CAQM, IIT Delhi, and CREDAI NCR also agreed to continue joint efforts to pilot the implementation framework across major urban centers in NCR.



CREDAI NCR (Ghaziabad) Gears Up for Growth Conclave 2025: EC & GC Meet Charts the Roadmap

The Executive Committee (EC) of CREDAI NCR (Ghaziabad) convened a detailed planning meeting on 24th October to finalize preparations for the upcoming Growth Conclave 2025, scheduled for 30th October 2025 at Radisson Blu, Kaushambi, Ghaziabad. The Conclave, themed "Transforming Urban Landscape," aims to bring together policymakers, industry leaders, and real estate professionals to deliberate on the city's evolving urban narrative.

CREDAI NCR (Haryana) to launch large-scale plantation project in Gurugram Aravallis

CREDAI NCR (Haryana) is undertaking an ambitious afforestation and ecological restoration project in the Aravalli region of Gurugram. On 4th October 2025, representatives from CREDAI Haryana met Mr. Subhash Yadav, Chief Conservator of Forests, to discuss the initiative covering land adjoining Sushant University. The project aims to transform barren and bush-dominated areas into a thriving green ecosystem through a blend of planned plantation, natural regeneration, and eco-restoration measures.

The afforestation drive will commence before the monsoon season and will be supplemented by large-scale seed dispersal to promote natural jungle growth. Ecological protection will be ensured by scientifically diverting natural water flow while preserving existing vegetation and ground flora.

The project also includes a bush clearance strategy, where small Keekar bushes will be removed and monitored to prevent regrowth, maintaining the land's suitability for sustainable plantation. Infrastructure support features biofencing within the plantation area, boundary arrangements by the Forest Department, a nursery near Sushant University with saplings ready by January 2026, and water supply managed primarily by the Forest Department with minor pumping by CREDAI Haryana.

This initiative marks a significant collaboration between CREDAI NCR (Haryana) and the Forest Department, Government of Haryana, underscoring the real estate sector's commitment to environmental sustainability, biodiversity preservation, and community wellbeing.



CREDAI NCR Engages in Conciliatory
Dialogue to Streamline Developer Complaints

On 9th October 2025, a meeting was held between representatives of CREDAI NCR (Western U.P. & Ghaziabad) and the office of the Hon'ble Conciliator to deliberate upon the ongoing developer-wise complaint resolution process.

During the deliberations, it was proposed and agreed that the Conciliator's office will endeavour to schedule hearings and discussions on a developer-wise basis to ensure more focused and effective resolution of complaints. The case details will be shared in advance with both the concerned developers and CREDAI to enable better preparedness.

The Hon'ble Conciliator emphasized that it shall be the moral responsibility of CREDAI NCR (Western U.P. and Ghaziabad) to ensure the presence of appropriate representatives from member developer companies, equipped with viable and constructive solutions.

Furthermore, CREDAI NCR (Western U.P. and Ghaziabad) will communicate to the Conciliator's office, in advance, the name of the nominated representative for each case, along with a brief status line outlining whether the complaint is resolvable or not, and were not, specifying the reason. This proactive exchange of information is expected to enhance transparency and streamline the overall conciliation process.



CREDAI, NAREDCO urge RBI to cut repo rate in next meet to enhance housing demand

Realtors' body CREDAI and NAREDCO on Wednesday urged the RBI to reduce the key repo rate in the next monetary policy to boost demand for residential properties, especially of affordable homes.

They also hoped that banks would pass on the benefits of previous rate cuts to existing and new home loan borrowers.

Commenting on the RBI policy, CREDAI National President Shekhar Patel, said, The RBI's decision to hold the repo rate at 5.5 per cent gives the housing sector he steadiness it needs amid global uncertainty. Predictable borrowing costs llow buyers to plan long-term and give developers the clarity to progress inancing and projects." He noted that the recent GST rates rationalisation has fted consumer sentiment and increased demand across sectors.

While markets had anticipated a 25-basis point cut today, we remain hopeful the BI will deliver a cumulative 50-basis point easing this fiscal in two tranches,
