Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q. How do I nominate for the CREDAI Awards for Real Estate Excellence 2026?

Answer:

To nominate, visit <https://credai.org/real-estate-awards-2026/> review the nomination categories, rules, guidelines, and eligibility criteria, and submit the nomination form.

Q. What are the next steps after submitting the nomination form?

Answer:

Upon submission of the nomination form, please download the information requirement sheet from the website <https://credai.org/real-estate-awards-2026/>. Complete the sheet and email it to realestate.support@crsil.com, along with the required documents and information. Crsil team (Knowledge partner) will reach out to you within 15 days of post assessment of the information and documents provided. For documents transmitted via email, please ensure that attachment sizes do not exceed 15 megabytes (MB). If the file size surpasses 15 MB, please consider sharing the document in batches to avoid any transmission issues.

Q. What is the procedure for submitting photographs of the nominated project?

Answer:

The applicant needs to share geotagged photographs of the project (minimum 10 images). Location details should be clearly visible. These images should cover external view, elevation, internal structures, common amenities, landscaped area, clubhouse, main entrance, exit and also sewage treatment plant, generators, charging points if applicable. These photographs should be shared along with the completed information sheet and emailed to realestate.support@crsil.com.

Q. How can I determine the TIER-1 classification for the location of my nominated project?

Answer:

To determine the TIER-1 classification for your nominated project's location, please refer to the city names available on the awards page: <https://credai.org/real-estate-awards-2026/>.

Q. Can I nominate ongoing/under construction project under any award category?

Answer:

No, ongoing projects are not eligible for nomination under any award category, only completed projects are eligible. A project is considered complete only if full occupancy/completion certificates have been obtained. The occupancy certificate or building use certificate or completion certificate must have been issued by the regulatory authority concerned between January 1, 2023, and July 31, 2026.
